President's Letter - So much to celebrate!

What an amazing year you have given us at *Building Up: Partnering In Health and Wholeness*. Another year of so many things to celebrate and be thankful for. I wish to extend a very special thank you to our faithful supporters who have believed in us and donated toward completing our goal of building the newly named *Tsiyon (Zion) Family Hospital (TFH)* in Sayyi, Uganda. The original name of the facility was *Zion Family Health Clinic*. Tsiyon means Zion in Hebrew.

We did it! The outpouring of support we received from the Zion Congregation and community has allowed us to complete all 4 Phases of construction. We look ahead to equip and staff the hospital in 2023. The plan is to open in phases as funds become available. In 2022 \$142,110.37 was raised with an additional inkind donation of \$5,500.

Our amazing Board of Directors and Advisory Council are to be commended for their diligence in overseeing this huge project. We had three (3) new Board Members and four (4) new Advisory Council members join our team in 2022. All are excited about helping to fulfill our mission.

Working with World Medical Relief of Southfield, MI we shipped a 40 ft container to Uganda filled with medical/dental equipment and supplies valued at \$460,880. A collection of donated medical equipment awaits a second shipment in 2023. In September the top floor of the *TFH* was furnished in anticipation of a *Building Up: PHW* team visiting in February 2023 to dedicate the *Tsiyon (Zion) Family Hospital*.

Additional funds went toward preparing a parking/entrance area for the hospital, the purchase of an adjacent lot for the location of an incinerator, and the installation of required appliances, toilets, sinks and showers. We hired a grant writer in November to help secure funds for equipment and staffing the hospital.

Thank you for your support and prayers. You have made it possible to build the *Tsiyon (Zion) Family Hospital* in 2 ½ years; nothing short of a miracle. It is my pleasure to serve you. I look forward to another successful year in 2023.

Building Up: Partnering In Health and Wholeness is a 501(c)3 nonprofit corporation organized for charitable purposes located in Ann Arbor, Michigan established in August 2020.

Our Mission:

The mission of BUILDING UP: PHW is to secure and connect resources with local and global entities to develop sustainable healthcare, wellness, and educational programs.

Our Project:

To build, equip and staff a new family medical/dental practice, Tsiyon (Zion) Family Hospital (TFH) in Sayyi, Uganda.

Our Goal:

To promote the health and well-being of the residents in the rural and economically depressed area of the greater Sayyi community. Currently only primitive medical services are available. No dental care is offered in the community. The new Tsiyon (Zion) Family Hospital will provide much needed critical care to this rural area of Uganda. Given that most people living in this area have no mode of transportation other than walking or bicycles, having medical and dental services available within a reasonable distance will offer immediate and ongoing health care. It will save thousands of lives!

Our Partners:

1. Tsiyon Family Healing Team, LTD, Sayyi, Uganda

Dr. Elia Musasizi and the Tsiyon Family Healing Team of Sayyi, Uganda are Building Up's main partner in Uganda. This group of professionals, organized by Dr. Elia Musasizi, gathered input from the residents of the Sayyi community, creating the vision and design for the TFH. In turn, Building Up's Board and Advisory Council collaborated with the Tsiyon Team throughout the design and building process.

2. Zion Lutheran Church, Ann Arbor, Michigan

Assistant Pastor, Vicky Lovell organized and led 4 mission trips to Uganda providing the catalyst that initiated the development of *Building Up: Partnering in Health and Wholeness*.

ZLC is the original sponsor of *Building Up* and provides the support mechanisms to our organization. ZLC provides meeting space, our mailing address, and communication services through its publications and electronic media.

3. Stone and Compass, Marblehead, Massachusetts

Stone and Compass, a 501(c)3, serves as an incubator and training force for global partnerships and projects that help build a vibrant future full of hope, financial security, peace, and happiness.
